- Council Tax?
- Out of control debt?

Do you just find it difficult filling in the forms?

Alabaré can help you with a free confidential advice service.

Our aim is to prevent homelessness for both single people and families.

If your income support, JSA or ESA is stopped or suspended, your housing benefit may also stop: this can lead to rent arrears and you could lose your home.

Help is at hand. We offer a weekly clinic service in Bideford where you can come and see an experienced Support Worker who can offer practical advice and support.

If you need some help our clinic appointments are easy to access and we can see you for up to three visits.

Floating Support Service

If you need more in-depth support we also offer a Floating Support Service* where you will receive on-going support in your own home.

If you are in danger of becoming homeless; or if you need to find a home more suited to your current needs, then we may be able to help.

We have special Support Workers who can visit you in your own home, or another arranged location, to advise you with issues such as

understanding tenancy agreements, budgeting and benefits.

They can also help advise you if you are in debt, or need to arrange payment plans with companies that you owe money to.

*“Floating Housing Support” is a technical term for a service which can help you if you live in your own home, but are struggling and need some help to avoid losing your tenancy. (When you no longer need the service it ‘floats’ away.)

At Alabaré we provide the highest standards of accommodation and support to disadvantaged and vulnerable people in our communities in order that they can have a home, health, choice and independence.

Since 1991, we have been working with people facing disadvantage through homelessness, mental ill-health, learning disability or a combination of these. We provide housing and personalised support based on the individual needs and aspirations of each person, tackling underlying causes and giving them the skills and confidence to move forward with their lives.

Our vision in Alabaré is a society where everyone has the opportunity to live a fulfilling life.
