We support vulnerable and disadvantaged young people, including those leaving the care system as well as young parents and their babies. We help them gain the skills and confidence to lead successful adult lives.

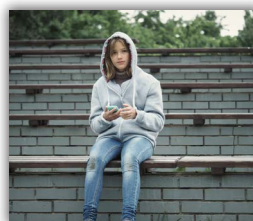


Homeless & Vulnerable Veterans

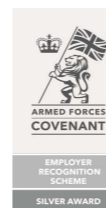

We are a leading UK charity committed to breaking the cycle of homelessness.

Every night, 354,000* people go to sleep homeless, feeling forgotten and alone. At ALABARÉ, we believe everyone deserves a place to call home, a heart that is restored, and a mind that is empowered. We support thousands of people each year through our homes and services across the South West of England and Wales.

At ALABARÉ we:

- **Provide Homes** – We offer more than shelter. We give people a safe, stable place to rebuild their lives.

Over 35 years, our charity has grown and developed to what it is today:

- 3,272 people supported in 2024-2025
- 361 bedspaces in our homes
- Over 270 colleagues and 170 volunteers support our clients
