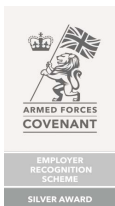

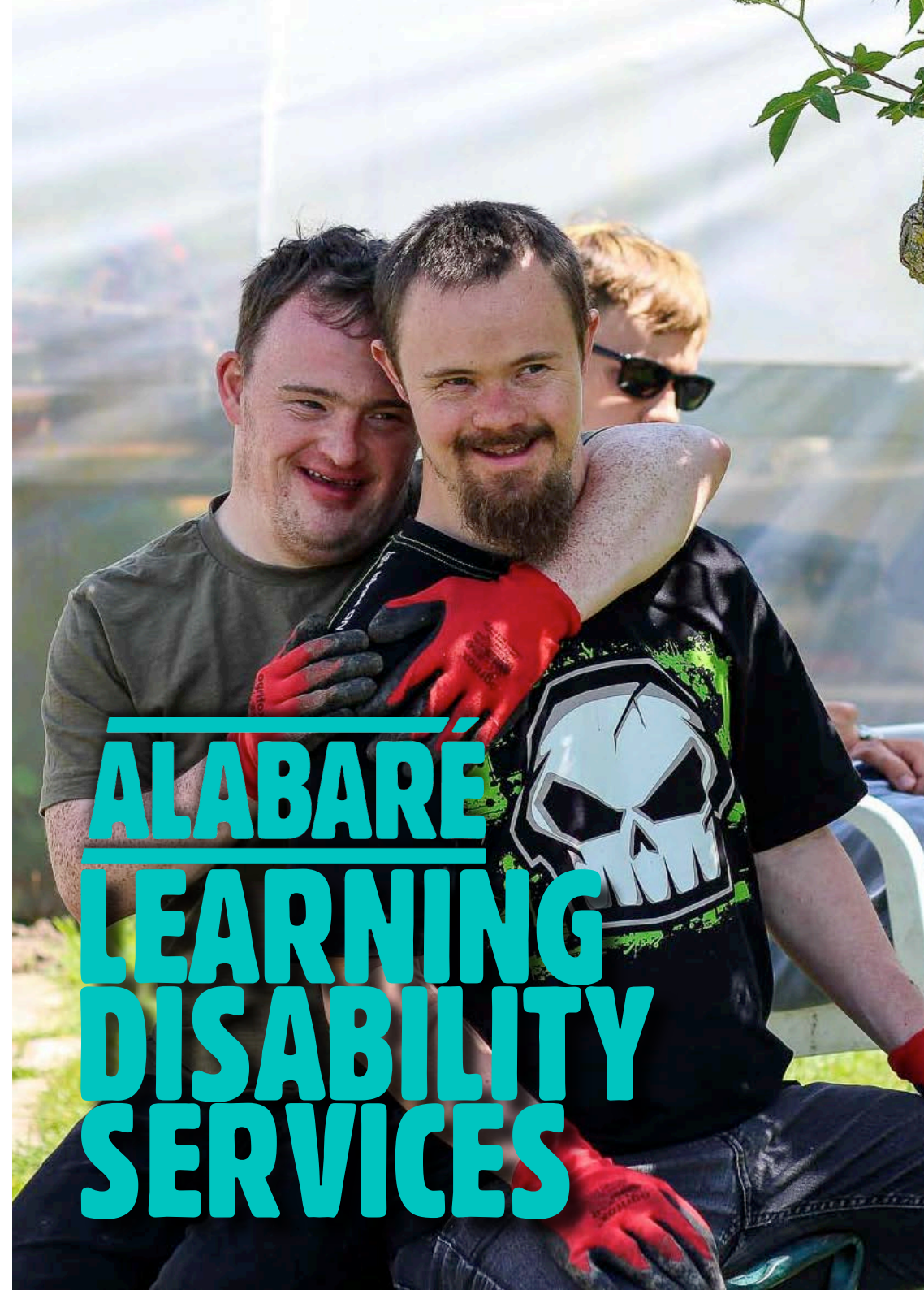

LIFE WITH ALABARÉ

Each of our homes is just that, a home. Residents form a strong community and support each other to look after their home. Each person is encouraged to personalise their room and has a vote in decisions affecting the whole house. There are regular house events and leisure opportunities and the ALABARÉ supported living community often come together to celebrate.

By encouraging residents to make personal choice, and supporting them to pursue their aspirations through activities we can help each person to live as independently as possible. Where residents have specific needs, we can help them to access specialised support.

Each resident is closely supported by their individual support worker (key worker) and together they agree a plan which ensures they have the help they need, and a focus to achieve their goals. We help residents to develop domestic and practical skills to help them stay safe and secure, and encourage increased awareness of their personal responsibilities. We have a range of home providing different levels of support so that we can give everyone just what they need.
